The Rules and Regulations of the Grand Chapter of New Hampshire, Order of the Eastern Star, Article XV, Section 5C states that: “The suspension, expulsion, or demission of a Brother from a Lodge of Master Masons deprives him of all the rights and privileges of membership in this Order until satisfactory evidence of his reinstatement by said Lodge has been presented to the Chapter and noted in its minutes.”

Furthermore, Article XIX, Section 5G.1. states that “The Secretary of the primary Chapter shall immediately, on notification from the Grand Secretary that a member who has been suspended or demitted, from Masonic membership, send a ‘Masonic Affiliation Inquiry Letter’ via certified mail.

We understand that during Masonic Affiliation there may be changes in membership. Please confirm your membership of another Masonic body in another jurisdiction, otherwise the Chapter will have no other option than ending your membership in the Order of the Eastern Star in New Hampshire.
